## POST-OPERATIVE WOUND CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Leave dressing on dry surgical site for 24 hours.
  Remove dressing and gently cleanse with hydrogen peroxide.
  Apply Polysporin or Bacitracin cintment or cream to dry your
- 3. Apply Polysporin or Bacitracin ointment or cream to dry wound (<u>do not</u> use Neosporin).
- 4. Cover with sterile adhesive bandage strip, and cut tape edges.
- 5. Change dressing \_\_\_\_ times daily for \_\_\_\_ days and keep dry.
- 6. After wound has completely healed for \_\_\_\_ days after sutures have been removed, apply MEDERMA SKIN CARE FOR SCARS (available from your pharmacist) 2-3 times a day for approximately 8 weeks or until scar appearance is satisfactory.

Do not apply MEDERMA SKIN CARE FOR SCARS to open wound. If bleeding occurs, apply constant pressure to wound site for 20 minutes. In the event of excessive swelling, prolonged redness, drainage, or tenderness, be sure to call this office.
